knowing that I must shortly depart this life deem
it right and proper both as it respects my family
and myself that I should make a disposition of
the property with which a kind Providence has blessed
me with. I do therefore make this my last will and a
testament hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me
1st Item, I desire and direct that my body be buried in
a christian like manner suitable to my circumstances
and condition in life My soul I trust shall return to
rest with God who gave it as I hope for eternal
salvation through the merits and atonement of
the blessed Lord and savior Jesus Christ whose religion
I have possessed and as I humbly trust have enjoyed
for many years past -

Item 2^d I desire and direct that all my just debts be
paid without delay by my executors herein after appointed
as I am unwilling my creditors should be delayed in
their rights as there is no necessity for delay -

Item 3^d I give and bequeath to my loving wife Sarah
the Lot of Land I now live on in Henry County and
second district known as Lot No 91, King on and
also the notes and money for and during her natural
life or her widowhood only and all other property
she may stand in need of for her comfort and
support.

Item 4th The balance of my stock that my beloved
wife Sarah owns, stands in need of. The balance to
be sold after my death & to be equally divided between
my four children share and share alike -

Item 5th I give and bequeath to Maria Richardson
the bed and clothing that belongs to the bed that she
lies in if she should not get it before my death
and fifty dollars in money at my death and
Twenty five dollars in money at the death of wife
Sarah

Item 6th I give and bequeath to my son in Law
William M Rhoads after the death of my wife
Sarah the Lot of Land I now live on in the
County and district above mentioned Lot 91, for

must pay bene humans and fifty dollars at
my death to pay my Son George B Lewis
Item 7th I desire after the death of my wife
Sarah all the balance of my personal property
which has not been sold before, to be sold and
the proceeds to be equally divided between my
four children share and share alike

Item 8th I desire that all the property that is
in the hands of my wife Sarah after her death
after her just debts be paid all the money or
what other property she may have in her hands
at her death to be equally divided among my
four children share and share alike

Item 9th I hereby constitute and appoint my son
George B Lewis Executor of this my last will
and testament this nineteenth day of August 1834
Thousand Eight hundred and forty nine
Given under my hand and seal
George B Lewis (Jr)
