 will & Testament in manner and form following to wit
 First I Bury my soul to God who gave it and my body to the
 Earth from whence it came to be buried in a Christian like
 manner by my Executors

Second As for such worldly Goods as it has pleased God to
 bless me with I dispose of in the following manner and wish
 in the first place all my Due debts be paid
 Third My Will and desire is that enough of my property be
 sold to best the best advantage by my Executors to pay
 all my debts and the remainder I give unto my beloved wife
 during her natural life or widowhood and when she
 deserts this life or should she marry then I wish all to
 be sold and the proceeds to be equally divided amongst all
 my love Miss my wife having an equal part with my
 children

Fourth My Will is that such land as I own in other counties
 and such other property as I own which is not
 absolutely necessary for the support of my family should
 be sold first for the payment of my debts and should
 that not be sufficient then I wish such things sold
 as my wife and Executors may think best
 but I wish the land wherein I now live and the
 negroes should not be sold unless it be necessary.

Fifth to pay my debts

My Will is that my wife shall have the knowledge to sell
 of selling the land wherein I now live if she should
 become desirous to live an it and apply the money
 to the purchase of other lands which may be desired
 and held as a part of my Estate and subject to sale
 and division in the same manner and under the same
 conditions as the balance of my Estate

And lastly I nominate constable and appoint my beloved
 wife Angelina Smith Executors and my Trusty
 friends Thos D Johnson & William H White my
 Executors to execute this my last will and Testament
