State of Georgia

April 17th 1842

Henry County } In the name of God amen I George W Young
of the County and State of fore said being weak in body
but in my sound and common mind. whereas it has pleased
Almighty God to bless me with a earthly estate and life is
uncertain I have thought proper to make this my last
Will and Testament for the purpon of the legal and rightfull
distribution of the same now after my body is decently Entured
which will be Decretionary with my family and friends
my desire and wish is that the following be the manner in
which my worldly estate be managed

1st I commit my body unto its mother earth from whence
it came and my Spirit unto the God that gave it

2^d I will that all my Just debts be paid

3^d I will & bequeath to my wife Margaret Katharine Young
during her Natural life or widowhood all of my household and
kitchen furniture also the settlement of land on which
I now live containing about three hundred and seventy

five acres being lots Number two hundred and fifty six in
 the eleventh district of Henry County and lot Number one in
 the fifth district of Decatur County also one lot of land
 containing one hundred and sixty acres number one hundred
 and sixty one in Walker County Eleventh District also my share
 in a lot of land in the right of my Wife Margaret N in
 originally Muscogee Stewart County also all of my horses mares
 stock of cattle hogs and sheep Also all of my negro or
 slaves viz Aggy a woman about thirty five years of age
 Harriet a woman about sixteen Markenton a boy about
 Eleven years of age Berry a boy about seven years of age
 Dick a boy about seventeen and Henry a boy about
 sixteen years of age all of which I will and bequeath
 to my Wife Margaret during her natural life time or
 widowhood as above stated in this my last will and tes-
 tament with the privilege of disposing of any of the stocks
 that may be thought best for the education of the children
 but in case of the marriage of my wife I wish my property
 both real and personal brought to sale and an equal division
 made with all of the lawfull legatees this being my last will
 and testament I have thought proper to appoint Margaret
 Katharine Young my Wife George L. M. Promore and Samuel
 C. Masters my sole Executors of the same
