Item the First

I devise and direct that my body be buried in
a decent and christianlike manner suitable to my circum-
stances and condition my soul I trust shall return to
rest with God who gave it as I hope for Eternal salvation
through the blessed Lord and Savior Jesus Christ

Item second

I give and devise to my beloved wife Sarah
for and during her natural life or widowhood the following
property to wit one lot of land whereon I now reside
being number eight in the eleventh district of Henry
County containing two hundred two and a half acres
one negro man by the name of Jack one negro woman
by the name of Winny one negro woman of black com-
plexion known as the house woman by the name of
Diddy one Sarrel mare and her two colts one of which
being a mule colt one set of farming tools and a
sufficiency of cooking utensils for her use also one bed
and bed furniture sufficient for the same

Item third

The remainder of my negroes I desire to be
valued and put in lots as near equal as possible and
should there be a difference in value of the several
lots the same shall be made equal in money so as
not to give one a larger share than another and
the balance of my real and personal estate I will
to be sold at such time and upon such terms as
my legal representation may deem best for the Interest
of all concerned and the proceeds thereof together
with the negroes above mentioned I will and
bequeath in the following manner

Item fourth

I give to each of my sons ^{by}

and William D. one tenth share of my negroes and proceeds
of sale of my real and personal property as mentioned in
Item the third

Item Fifth

I will to my son Isaac J as trustee for
each of my Daughters to wit Caroline E Everitt
Sarah E. Maddox and Frances Philena and their
bodily heirs each one tenth share of my negroes
and proceeds of sale of my real and personal property
as mentioned in Item ^{the} third which several shares as
willed to the said Isaac as trustee aforesaid. I bequeath for
the sole benefit and use of my said daughters and their
bodily heirs as before specified depallowing the sale or
transfer thereof for any other cause or purpose than
that herein mentioned

Item Sixth

I will to my son Mons A as Trustee and
Guardian for my Grandchildren to wit the children
of my deceased daughter Eliza M Chapman viz
William M. William H. Edwin E Sarah E Caroline
and Elijah Chapman together an equal share of
my estate with my children herein before mentioned
being one tenth part thereof to be paid to them in cash
ratable as they may become of lawful age this
bequeath I make to my said grandchildren above men-
tioned for their sole use and benefit of them and their
bodily heirs

I give to my son in law Elijah M Chapman
the sum of one dollar

Item eighth

I give to my son in law Eli Everitt
the sum of one dollar

Item Ninth

I give to my son in law William L
Maddox the sum of one dollar
