just debts & the legacies aforesaid the whole of my property
real & personal to my beloved wife Gilly Daniel
during her natural life and after her death I will & direct
that the whole of my estate real & personal be sold and
after paying all expenses equally divide amongst my
children to wit Elizabeth Daniel widow of John
Daniel deceased John Daniel Daniel Daniel
Barry Daniel James Daniel & Albert Daniel
Dorimar ~~Adeline~~ wife of Milton Adeline and
their children forever hereafter forever & leaving my said
daughters Mary Elias Polly Summerlin widows of Thomas
Summerlin deceased from any part of my estate other
than is named in Item the third in this my last
will & testament

Item the fifth I hereby constitute and appoint my son
in law Milton Adeline my executor to this my last
will and testament
