sum jointly & severally & firmly by these
presents sealed with our seals and dated this
Tenth day of May 1827. —

The Condi-
-tion of the above obligation is such that if
the above bound John & Eliza & Elizabeth
Fletcher do administer all the goods
Chattels & Credits of the said James Fletcher
Late of Henry County deceased which have or
shall come into the hands possession or know-
ledge of the said John & Eliza & Elizabeth
Fletcher — on the hands of possession
of any person or persons for them and
the same do make do Exhibit unto the said Court
of Ordinary when they shall be there unto required
and such goods Chattels & Credits do well &
truly Administer according to Law and do make
a just & true account of their Actings & doing
therein when they shall thereunto be required by
the Court; Shall deliver and pay to such
person or persons respectively as they may
be entitled to the same by Law

And if it shall hereafter appear
that any Last will & Testament was
made by the deceased and the same
be proven before the Court of
Ordinary & Executor obtain a
Certificate of the probate thereof
and John (D) Hall & Elizabeth Fletcher
in such case if refused under up
the said Letters of Administration
then this obligation to be void
else to remain in full force.
