Item 3rd } I nominate & appoint C. R. Nolan my Executor
to see to & carry out the provisions of this will—

& affixed my seal this 18th November 1861—James W. J.

his Last will & Testament in the presence of us
who subscribed the same as witnesses & in presence of
Testators & in presence of each other 18th November 1861—
