 of the Court of ordinary for said County &
 their Successors in office, in the Cash and full
 sum of Twelve hundred dollars, for the payment
 of which sum to the said Court of Justice,
 & their Successors in office, we bind our Selves,
 our heirs, Executors and administrators in the
 whole and for the whole sum jointly, and
 severally and firmly by these presents, sealed
 with our seals and dated (This 3rd day of
 Sept^r 1827.

The Condition of the above obligation
 is such that if the above bound John Patterson
 and John Williams Securities of the Goods
 Chattels, and Credits of the Estate of James
 Graham Late of Baldwin County Deceased,
 which have or shall come into the hands possession
 or knowledge of the said Cell Party
 or the hands or possession of any person or
 persons for him, and the same so made as Exhibit
 unto the said Court of Ordinary when he shall
 be thereunto required, and such goods, and chattels,
 do well and truly administer according to Law,
 and so make a Just and True account of his
 acting and doings therein, when he shall
 thereunto be required by the Court. Shall deliver
 and pay to such person or persons respectively,
 as they may be entitled to the same by Law
 And if it shall hereafter appear that
 any Just will and Testament was made

before the court of Ordinary and Executor

this obligation to be void, else to remain in full
