born to die do make this my last Will
and Testament in following manner to wit
I recommend my body to the dust to be
buried in a Christian like manner and
my soul to God who gave it in hope to
be raised at the resurrection of the just
and touching my worldly estate which
God in his providence has given me

I Give & bequeath in the manner following
ie I allow all my last debts to be paid
out of the present crop or any other perishable
property that my well beloved wife
Travis may think proper to dispose of first
I allow my well beloved wife Travis
to have all my lands & all my
stock house hold and kitchen furniture
& horses & my negroy Ben & house to my
wife during her life or widowhood
if she survives all the ~~the~~ property to be
sold and one half of the proceeds to be
given to my well beloved ^{wife} Travis
the other half to be equally divided
between my children then living I ordain

my last will and testament ratifying
confirming this to be my last will
and testament where by this annulling
all former wills and testaments where
of I set my hand and affixed my seal
this the 25th day of August 1835
