 & County above written being very weak of body But of sound  
 mind & memory Thanks be to God God for it & Calling to mind  
 the mortality of my body. & knowing it is appointed to all men once  
 to die do make & ordain this my last will & Testament that is to  
 say principally & first of all I Give & Recommend my soul in to the hands  
 of almighty God who Giveth & My body I Recommend to the earth to  
 be buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors  
 nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive it again  
 by the mighty power of God & as touching such worldly Estate when with  
 It has pleased God to bless me in this life I Give devise & dispose of same in  
 the following manner & from first it is my will that a Square 50 Acres of Lot  
 No 227. in the 3<sup>d</sup> Dist of Henry County South west corner said Lot shall  
 be sold & the said money arising from the sale shall be applied to pay  
 my Just debts & it is my will that my wife Sarah Barr shall have  
 all my Real & personable property during her life not otherwise disposed  
 of & then to be Equally divided between David Barr & John Barr  
 2<sup>d</sup> it is my will that Robert S Barr shall have a Square of 500 Acres  
 of Lot No 227. in the 3<sup>d</sup> District of Henry County Situate & lying in  
 North west corner of said Lot  
 4<sup>thly</sup> I do hereby nominate & ordain my wife Sarah Barr my Executrix  
 & Elisha McButcher my Lawfull Executors of this my Last will &  
 Testament ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my Last will  
 & Testament in witness whereof I have here unto Affixed my Hand  
 & Set my Seal this 1<sup>st</sup> day of February 1835- in presence of  
 Edwin Wall
