 negroes to wit George & Ann

5th I Give unto my Son-in-law Green Mullins Two negroes
 to wit Lock a man - Turda his wife & three hundred
 & seventy five dollars in money

6th I Give unto Elizabeth Hudman wife of my son
 William now dead fifteen hundred dollars in money

7th My wish is that Michael & Judah shall live
 with either of my children that they may choose to
 live with which is to be left entirely to their choice

8th I lend unto my daughter Dese Pooker during her
 life one negro man named Ben & after her death to
 be divided amongst my children

9th I Give unto my beloved wife or during her life
 one negro girl named Belad and after her death
 to be divided amongst my children

2^d I Give unto the children of my daughter Mary Casaway now dead to be equally divided amongst them three Negroes to wit George Ann & Mohala

3^d I Give unto Elizabeth Hudman wife of my son William now dead Twelve hundred Dollars in money

4th I hereby ratify & confirm first second fifth sixth seventh eighth & Ninth Items of the foregoing will and my Will is that my lands stock & such things as are not mentioned in this will be sold & the money applied to the payment of the Legacies therein contained

Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my son Phiziah Hudman & my son in law Lewis Lawley my Executors to Execute this my last will & Testament in In Testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand & Seal the 16th day Sept in the year 1836 —

my lawful debts, I will and bequeath to my loving wife
Nancy Miller the one third part of all the balance of my
estate for her support enduring life and at her death to
return to her children
Item 7th I will and bequeath to John McBride Miller, Frank
Miller, James Miller, Henry Miller all the balance of my
estate that I am now possessed of or hereafter may be
