being of advanced age and knowing that I must shortly
depart this life deem it right and proper both as respects my
family and myself that I should make a disposition of
the property with which a kind providence has blessed me
therefore make this my last will and testament hereby
revoing all others heretofore made by me

Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried
in a decent and christian like manner suitable to my
circumstances and condition in life. My soul I trust
shall return to rest with God who gave it as I hope for
eternal salvation through the merits and atonement of the
blessed Lord and Savior Jesus Christ whose religion I
have professed and as I hope and humbly trust enjoyed
for many years

Item 2nd I desire and direct that all my just debts be
paid without delay by my executors hereafter appointed
as I am unwilling my creditors should be delayed in
their rights especially as there is no necessity for delay.

Item 3rd I desire and hereby direct that all my property
both real ~~and~~ personal and mixed left by me after my
death be sold and turned into money and I direct that
all my children now living to wit Edmond W Jackson
Elizabeth Ezzell Mary R Ragland Ann A Thom William
W Jackson and I also desire and hereby direct that my
grand children the children of my daughter Sandal L
Ragland to wit Mary Ann Turner wife of William B Turner
Sarah J Scott wife of Henry M Scott Thomas J Ragland
John W Ragland Robert W Ragland and Lemuel A Ragland
receive out of said funds one distributed share with my
children above named and I give and bequeath unto my
~~said~~ said several children so named to share equally
and that my grand children so named to share equally
with each other and all of said grand children so named
to draw or have one share equally to one of the children
shares with this provision that the share I give my daughter
Mary R Ragland the right of the same is exclusively vested
in her subject alone to her own disposal forever

Item 4th I hereby constitute and appoint my son William W
Jackson and my son-in-law Lemuel Ragland and my friend Dr Francis
C Hansen Executors of this my last will and testament this 28th day of March
1860
