Item 1st I will that as soon as funds for the same
shall be procured all debts that I may owe
at my decease shall be paid
Item 2nd I will that my wife Amy Lyle (in consideration
of its being derived from the estate of her father)
shall possess my family Carriage
Item 3rd I will that as soon as practicable after my decease
that my executors here after to be named shall
advertise at three or more public places the sale
of all of my estate both real & personal except
the Carriage above named & shall sell the same at
public outcry at such time & place as my executors
shall deem most conducive to the interests of
my said estate in all transactions to do it
in the least expensive manner so as justice to all
& my legacies be done

I will that my wife Amy Lyle for her comfort & maintenance shall receive the One Third of the proceeds of my whole estate and that she retain it during her natural life & at her death what ever remains of said Third of my estate be equally divided betwixt the whole of my Children Viz Mary Hancock Matthew Lyle Elizabeth Whaley Joshua W Lyle Robert S. Lyle Emily McWilliams and Amanda L Sanders. And that the whole residue of the proceeds of my estate be distributed as follows First my Son Robert Lyle & my daughter Elizabeth Whaley shall receive one hundred & twenty dollars & that they together with the rest of my above named Children shall each receive an equal share of the residue of the proceeds of my Estate My sons Matthew, Joshua & Robert each their distributive portion to their own use to be disposed of at their discretion & that the share of each of my daughters is to inure to the benefit of my above named daughters. Mary Hancock Elizabeth Whaley, Emily McWilliams & Amanda L Sanders & the heirs of their body and not subject to be used or disposed in any manner except the maintenance & comfort of my said Daughters & the heirs of their body. Finally, I appoint My wife Amy Lyle and my son Matthew Lyle my executors to execute this my last will and Testament.
