fifteen hundred dollars, for the payment of which
sums to the said Justices & their successors we bind
our selves, our heirs, Executors & Administrators, in the
whole & for the whole sum jointly, & severally, and
firmly, by these presents, sealed with our seals, & dated
this 28th day of Jan'y 1828.

The condition of the above
obligation is such, that if the above bound
Jacob McKee administrator of the goods, Chattels &
Credits of John McKee deceased, do make a true and
perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods, Chattels
& Credits of said deceased, which have or shall come
to the hands, possession or knowledge of the said Ja-
cob McKee, or into the hands or possession of any other per-
son or persons for him; & the same, so made, do Exhibit
unto the said Court of Ordinary, when he shall be
thereunto required; and such goods, Chattels & Credits,
as well and truly administer according to Law, &
do make a just & true account of his actings & doings
therein, when he shall be thereunto required by the
Superior Court or the Court of Ordinary for said
County, and all the rest of the goods, Chattels and
Credits, which shall be found remaining upon the
account of the said administration, the same
the same being first allowed by the Court, shall
deliver & pay to such person or persons.
