by the name of Maria to stay & continue with her until
her youngest Child Benjamin comes to the age of seventeen years
then the above named Negro Woman shall be with her bodily
in Case if any to be sold & the profits arising from such
Sale to be equally divided amongst my Children that I had
by my first wife alsoe one Negro Woman named Alice & her
Son sold to my Wife Anna during her life time or widowhood
them they to be sold & the money to be equally divided between
her four Children namely Ansel Correll & Susanah Corral
Major Ray & Benjamin Ray & after the Expiration of my Wifes life
or widowhood as the case may be the land whereon she lives
to become the property of my two youngest Children Major &
Benjamin Ray also I do Reserve a part of the estate of my prop-
erty Two hundred Dollars which may I wish to be ap-
pointed to sole use of Schooling my Two youngest Children
Major & Benjamin Ray

In the second place I do appoint my Son Demassey Ray
to be my lawfull Executor to attend to my business in 1st
place to pay all my just debts & to see that my wife
Shall not be imposed on by her law presaby Corral nor by
son in law Merrim Ecals for it is not my will that they shall
Engage any of the benefits of my property in life or after
Death thirdly I will that my property be & Continue
on the place where I now live under the care of my young
Washington until he comes Twenty one years of age then
after Reserving for the use of my wife two feather beds
& furniture 1 Bright Box more 5 years old also a suffi-
ficiency of plantation tools for forming & cooking utensils
for house keeping keeping the balance of my property
in Including Eight Negroes my stock of horses hogs
Cattle & Sheep in Cluding house hold & kitchen furniture

and plantation Tools also Two Waggon & Cart of
Blacksmith Tools I will to be sold & Equally divided
amongst my Children Polly Dickenson Sally Myatt
John Ray George O Ray Alfred P Ray Hamard
R Ray Betsy McClain Cassander Brown
Scrippin Ray Buckram H Ray Young M Ray
With the exception of an lot of land lying & being
& being in the 10th Dist of Muscogee Country in the State
of Georgia known by the No 295 also I Give to my Son
Young M Ray an horse more than years old past
and Calf Cow & foal & for the above named land
to be the property of my Two youngest Children Major &
Benjamin Ray also My Wife to have & hold to her
for her support at the time of such sale of property
Tools Cows & calves one Cow & Pigs with a sufficiency
of Killings hogs to support the family that year & the next
following Wilness wherof I have hereunto sette
My hand and affixed My Seal this day & year first
