and as I humbly trust enjoyed for these many years

It 2<sup>d</sup> I desire my last debts be all paid without  
delay by my Executor or Executors herein after named  
as I am unwilling my creditors should be delayed  
of their rights especially as there is no necessity of  
delay

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 It 3<sup>d</sup> I give and devise to my beloved wife Mary during her natural life or widowhood with whom I have lived in the strictest quiet and love for many years one lot of land the same being the lot whereon I now reside and known by the number one hundred ninety two in the eighth District of the county and state aforesaid also one negro woman slave by the name of Patience & three children namely Martha Dick and Greenbury with all the rights to the land named and to cultivate the same for her own proper use during her life time or widowhood also one bay horse known by the name of Fox also one cow & calf also one bed and furniture one sow & pigs also a supply of cooking & table utensils for house keeping also a supply of provision for her support for the ensuing year also the property that she had at the time of our Inter-marriage

It 4<sup>th</sup> I give and devise that the balance of my Estate both real & personal after my decease be sold and after my last debts are paid that it be equally divided amongst my children as follows namely that the children of my son Elyah Godson receive one eighth share with the rest of my children namely Samuel Godson William Godson Andrew D Hollis the son of my daughter Ruth Hollis Josiah Godson also my daughter Lucy Rowley to have an equal share with the rest of my children which I give and bequeath to her and to her body heirs after her death

It 5<sup>th</sup> I devise that my son Samuel Godson and William Godson be my lawful Executors to act and do and perform all the duties required as Executor of this my last will & Testament in testimony whereof I have this day set my hand and seal in the presence of
