or knowledge of the said Thomas D
Johnson Executor as aforesaid or the hands
or possession of any person or persons for him
or the same do make do Exhibit to the said
Court of ordinary when he shall be thereunto
unto required and such goods Chattels and
Credits do well and truly administer ac-
cording to Law and do make a Just and true
account of his actings and doings therein
when he shall thereunto be required by
the Court shall deliver and pay to such
person or persons respectively as they may
be entitled by Law. and if it shall
hereafter appear that if any last
