

Considering the uncertainty of their mortal life and being of sound mind and memory blessed be Almity god for the same do make and publish this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say —

Item, I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Nancy Lights the lot of Land where on I now live know by no 215 the hundred & fifteen her life time also I give to her Three negroes of the following description one woman by the name of Janny one boy by the name of Tom one girl Charlotte also one boy more and a colt & choice cow & calves 2 hogs and furniture one half of the house hold & kitchen furnished with all money and notes & accounts except one hundred dollars to be applied to the payment of a lot of Land known by no 236

2nd I give unto Ester Burnard one lot of Land no 236, also four negroes namely one negro man bonus one woman Lucy one boy by me one girl Nancy one man & colt a dark Chestnut horse together with all my remaining stock of cattle Cows hogs & Sheep also my Wagon with all my plantation tools of all description together with two beds & furniture one half of my house hold & kitchen furniture

3rd I give unto my nephew David Lights the sum of three hundred dollars upon the condition he stays with my family until he is of age say twenty one years old to be paid quarterly out of my estate if he should die before that time the money shall revert back to my estate

Lastly I appoint Jacob Burnham my Son in Law and William Andrews my sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other Wills by me made in

Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the eleventh of June 1831

Signed Sealed and declared by the above Joseph Lights to be his last will and testament in presence of us William Griffin Christopher Wiggin & Mrs Andrews the above was proven by the oaths of William Griffin and Christopher Wiggin the 3d July 1837 and admitted to record no objection qualified
