my last will and testament revoking all other
wills and testaments by me made. This will made
by me the tenth of February Eighteen hundred and
Forty— I then First I will call my property that I
may have at my decease be sold my lawful
debts be paid of my estate. all notes and accounts
to be collected by my executor here after named
and the money be paid to my children as this my
last will and testament may direct by my lawful
Executor— I then as I have given up to my daughter
Indeth E. Tanner wife of Floyd Tanner in my lifetime
an Negro Girl named Malinda with all her move
able that was arise after she was given up to my
said daughter to her and her heirs forever. also I
give her one young mare saddle and Bridle and cow
and calf and father bed and furniture Ten
Dollars in silver and other articles to mention
the worth of property that I give her amounting to five
hundred and Thirty three dollars I will there be
paid out of my estate by my lawful Executor
Two dollars with property I have given up to her in my
lifetime and the Two dollars I leave her at my
Decease I will it to her and her heirs forever as
it is intend for her full share of my estate
I then I have given up to my son Sifer W. Tanner one
hundred acres of land lying in Lincoln county and
horse and father Bed and other articles to mention
the whole amounting to five hundred
and Thirty Two dollars I will there be paid to
him my said son by my lawful Executor two
Dollars out of my estate it is intended by me
for his full share of my estate
I then I have given to my Daughter Sarah E. Danell
an Negro girl in my lifetime named Clara
two young mares two saddles and bridles five head
of cattle and father Bed and furniture all
which property I have given up to my Daughter
and her heirs forever I will there be paid

to her by my lawfull Executor two dollars it being
indebted by me for her full portion of my Estate
after my decease
I then as I have given to my son Joseph B Tanner
two negroes and negro boy named George and negro
girl named Phibary and bed and furniture
other articles tedious to mention. I will then
be paid to my son Joseph B Tanner two dollars
at my decease by my lawfull Executor
I then will after my lawfull Executor has paid
the debts of my estate and has paid to my children
the money I have directed him I will four hun-
dred dollars be paid out of my Estate to William
H Tanner my son and his heirs forever
I then I will of the my lawfull Estate be paid and
the money paid over to my children. then I named
two dollars apiece I give to son Thomas J Tanner
four hundred dollars to him and his heirs forever
I then I will the money that be over left after the division
between my children before directed I will it be
Equally divided between three sons by my Executor
three names William H Tanner Thomas J Tanner
Joseph B Tanner which money I give to three
my said sons and their heirs forever
I then will my son William H Tanner Executor
on this my last will by me made, signed sealed
in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and
Forty - before Witnesses
