said being in a low state of health but of sound
disposing mind and memory and calling to mind the
mortality of the body and knowing that it is
appointed for all men once to die and after death
the Judgement do make publish and declare this
Instrument of writing to be and contain my last will
& testament in manner & following that is to say
First I will and desire that all my Just debts be
paid if not money on hand at my death to pay them
at the discretion of my loving wife Elizabeth D Roan
and my son Leonard Roan by sale of any of my
property that they may think proper to sell
for that purpose

Item 2^d I give to my loving wife Elizabeth D
Roan all the land and plantation whereon I now
live during her natural life time with all my
house hold and Kitchen furniture farming tools
and Implements with one half of the stock of
every kind, the other half to my son Leonard which may
be at the time of my death and as I request my son
Leonard to remain on the plantation and take care
of the family he is to have two thirds of all the
net profits of all the surplus produce that he shall
make for sale and sell after supporting the family
and the other to go to my wife Elizabeth D Roan. at the
death of my wife I will and desire that my house
hold and Kitchen furniture which may be on hand
at the death of my wife I will and desire may be sold
to the highest bidder on a twelve months credit giving
due and legal notice of the sale the property to be
sold by my son Leonard and the money arising
from said sale to be divided between my son Leonard
and daughter Delila Ann Roan Leonard having
two shares and Delila one share or if they think proper they
may divide the said property in the said states two to one
or if either or both of them should marry before the
death of my wife and property should be advanced to
them it is to be accounted for in the division
I will that my land one half of the stock farming
tools and implements be sold to the highest bidder

on a twelve months credit the land in which I now live under a
 other property on the premises where I now live under a
 fair notice I also will that my negro man George be also
 sold at the time & place of the sale of my other perishable
 property under the head stock I mean horses &c and
 the money arising from said sale to be divided as follows
 my son Leonard is to have three (3) shares Fanny Smith
 one share Delila Ann Roan one share Elizabeth Ann
 Beck one share and Mary Brooks one share each
 the shares or portions given to all my daughters Fanny Smith
 Elizabeth Ann Beck Delila Ann Roan & Mary Brooks is
 given to them and their children and not liable to
 the debts or contracts of their husbands further than
 to be used and controlled for the use and benefit of
 their wives & children all the sales and divisions of
 my property I wish to be done and transacted by my
 son Leonard Roan without order or control of the
 Court of Ordinary further than to prove and record
 this will and make an appraisement of my Estate
 and return and record the sale bill for the satisfaction
 of all concerned and Lastly I do hereby nominate &
 appoint my son Leonard Roan Executor of this my
 last will and Testament hereby revoking all other
 former wills by me at any other time heretofore made
 in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my seal this 18th day of February 1846

the eighth district of Appling containing (490) four
hundred and ninety acres & also a negro man slave by the
name of Ephraim and all my stock of Horses Cattle and
hogs & household & Kitchen Furniture & plantation tools
& every thing I have or may be possessed of as above
mentioned & I appoint & select P. J. Ward my Executor to
Carry out this my last will & Testament
