The condition of the
above obligation is such that if the above bound
Elizabeth Miller Administrator of the goods Chattels and
of the said said William Miller do make a true and
perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods and
Chattels and credits of said deceased which have
or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of
the said Elizabeth Miller or into the hands possession
of any other person or persons for her and the same
do make do Exhibit unto the said Court of ordinary
when she shall hereunto be required and such goods and
and Credits do with said Court Administrator account

to law and do make a just and true account
of his actings and doings therein when when she shall
be then unto required by the Court of Ordinary for said
County and at the rest of the goods chattels and
things which shall be found remaining upon the
account of the Administration the same being first
allowed of by the Court that deliver and pay to
such persons respectfully as are interested by law and
if it shall hereafter appear that any last will
and testament was made by the said deceased &
the same be proven before the Court and the Executors
obtain a certificate of the probat thereof and the said
Elizabeth Mills as in such case if required render &
deliver up the said letters of Administration then this
obligation to be void else remain in full force -
