

In the name of God, Amen, I Peter Wolf of the County of Henry & State of Georgia being of sound and disposing mind & memory & being desirous to settle my worldly affairs while I have strength to do so, make & publish this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all wills by me at any time heretofore made; and first I commit my soul to God who gave it: & my body I desire to be buried in a Christian like manner, and my worldly estate I dispose of as follows

Item First I will that all my just debts be paid

Item Second I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Olivia Wolf all my household & kitchen Furniture except one Bed Bedstead & Furniture

Item Third It is my desire that all my property not disposed of aforesaid shall be sold & the solvent notes collected

Item Fourth, I will & bequeath to my beloved Wife in addition to what I have already given her one thousand & six hundred Dollars in cash to be paid her by my Executor in fee simple for her support during her life. to be disposed of by her as she may choose for that purpose But in cash she should die before that amount is spent or should there be a portion of the six thousand dollars above named left: it is my desire that the balance if any should go back to my estate

Item 5th I will & bequeath all the remainder of my estate not disposed of above to be equally divided between my children share & share alike as follows to Phillips Wolf, Mary F. Stewart, Wilkey Welch, Leab Wolf, Simon P. Wolf, the children of Phoebe Park Decd. one share & the children of Elizabeth Crumwell Decd. one share

Item Sixth I hereby constitute and appoint my brother in law John

Stimell Executor to this my last Will & Testament.

half of the south east quarter of section nine in Township
twenty two of range twenty three in the district of
lands subject to sale at Montgomery Alabama con-
taining eighty acres, these two tracts I put to John W.
Daily at five hundred dollars.
Item Third. I give to Samuel C. Daily the north west
quarter of section 10 in Township twenty two
of range twenty three in the district of lands subject
