Daig my son, David Daig my son John Daig - for himself and as Trustee for my daughter Milly J. Selfridge, take each an equal share and I desire that my Executors herein after named may if they deem it proper sell the above named property for the purpose of equal division as above stated at any time or place which they may select

6th It is my wish and intention that my son John Daig hold any and all the property above bequeathed to my daughter Milly J. Selfridge as Trustee for her sole use and benefit and that said property be in no wise subject to the debts now existing or hereafter to be contracted of her husband John Selfridge or subject to his control and if my son John Daig shall die or from any cause become unable to perform his duty as Trustee then I name and appoint my son David Daig Trustee in his place and stead

7th I do not give or bequeath anything to my children William W. Gowan Horatio Gowan or to my

grand children who are the children of Christopher Bowen because they are already sufficiently provided for.

8th I nominate and appoint my son David Daig and my son John Daig Executors of this my last Will and Testament this 12th day of October 1847
