Last will & Testament in manner following

I command my soul into the hands of almighty God
I will that all my debts be fully paid and discharged
out of my effects after which I give and bequeath unto
My Son Robert Beard one ox. Cook and the utensils
thereunto belonging I give and bequeath unto My beloved
Son Wm the land & premises whereon I now live
after the decease of My Beloved wife Sarah I will
that my both of land lying the County of Lee originally
be immediately sold and the money arising from said
soil to belong to my beloved wife Sarah and after her
death to be equally divided among all my children
and I will and appoint William W Beard to sell the same
and execute letters to the same fully & authentically I will
that my Clock be sold and equally divided between
My three Sons I will & bequeath unto My beloved wife
Sarah during the period of her natural life all other
my effects whatsoever not hereinafter named for her Benefit
and that she may dispose of for her support or as she may otherwise
think proper And I do hereby nominate & appoint
My beloved wife Sarah & my beloved Son William to be
Executors to this my last will & Testament and revoking
all others in writing whereof I have hitherto set my
hand and affixed my this tenth day November one
thousand Eight hundred & thirty six

named that he did it freely & without compulsion so
far as they know or believe and they each signed the same
as witness at the request of the said Testator in his presence
and in the presence of each other Sworn to in open Court
