Secondly) I wish all my lawful debts & funeral expenses punctually & promptly paid.

Thirdly) I give & bequeath unto my three eldest children Sabra B. Bayers. Brown, Aliza. Richardson, & John. Brown. each Five dollars as their portion to them & their heirs forever.

Item 4th) I give & bequeath unto my son Archibald. Brown the Hundred acres of Land now live on being the North half of Number One hundred & Eighty Six in Second District of Henry County also One feather bed & furniture to him & his heirs forever.

Fifthly) I give & bequeath unto my two youngest daughters Mary. McVicker & Atha. Brown my negro boy David & all the residue or remainder of my property both real & personal not other wise disposed of the net amount after all expenses paid to be equally divided between my said two daughters Mary. McVicker & Atha. Brown to them & their heirs forever. Lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint my worthy friends The Messrs. William. Kimball. Williams. Adair. & Richard. B. G. Executors to this my last Will & Testament. Given under my hand & seal
