that all must ere long die & know not how soon it
may be my fate to make or daime & constitute this
my last will and Testament viz

Item 1st I will to my beloved Matilda Hammond one lot
of land no two hundred and fifty five 1/2 in the County
aforesaid and four negroes viz Cyrus Charlotte Jack
Sellar with all and every other species of property that
I may be in possession of at my death after paying all
my just debts

Item 2^d I appoint my beloved wife Matilda Hammond
my lawful executor of this my last will & Testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this 29th of January 1838
