

Henry County In the name of God Amen I Samuel McNamee of the County and State of Georgia being now advanced in years and calling to mind that is appointed for all men once to die being at this time of sound mind and memory and knowing from the course of nature that the remaining years of my life cannot be many do dispose of such worldly estate as I have possessed the Lord bless me with in the following manner that is to say first of all I recommend my soul to god who got it and my body to be buried in a christian like manner by my Executors here after named

Item 2 I will that all my just debts be paid in the first place and the amount thereof deducted from my estate.

Item 3 I give and bequeath unto my two eldest sons Daniel & James McNamee Six dollars each and to my Daughter An Mariah Patterson the sum of Six dollars and also to my Grand Daughter Nancy Ruth Patterson Six dollars provided she is living at my death and has heirs of her body but she dies without child or children then the sum of Six dollars set apart for her to be Equally divided between Daniel and James the heirs An Mariah Patterson I believe the amount I have give to them Daniel James An Mariah and Nancy Ruth will be fully equal to what the rest has got of my children hereafter named will get after paying my debts - I Give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary McNamee one shirt and frock one hood and apron and one cow & calf and two huffer molasses

Item 4 I give and bequeath to my two sons John & Daniel McNamee the south half of my land in Henry County being but one lot for partly compensating them for maintaining and tending care of my widowed wife during her life or removing a widow

Item 5 I Give to my Single Daughters each that is to say Harriet E. Francis Nancy & Elizabeth McNamee - and Eliza I give the

and furniture to be worth twenty five Dollars each and to be deducted out of ~~the~~ part of my estate
that all the remaining part of my property both real and personal to be ~~equally~~ sold and Equally divided among my children except those that I have here given Six dollars each which I think is their full share and they are not to receive any part of my estate except the amount herein provided out for them and my Land estate that is ~~is~~ Lying in Barker County in the state of Georgia I want sold by my Executors Either privately or at public sale in this county without going to Barker county for to do so and my daughters to receive their beds and furniture as they sherry on arrive at the age of twenty one I also give to my youngest son Samuel McNamee one hundred dollars over and above an Equal share to be first taken out of my Estate and to have an equal share with the rest of my children that has not got their certain portion provided out I hereby appoint my son John McNamee and James W. Crabtree my Executors to execute this my last Will and testament hereby revoking all former Wills heretofore made by me
