

State of Georgia, In the name of God Amen
Henry County I I Sarah Nagland of the State
and County aforesaid being of Sound Mind and
disposing Memory but Remaining from the Common
Course of nature the Remaining years of my life
must be few and Cuning now as my own right
and property the several itans hereinafter mentioned
do dispose of the same to take effect after my
death in the manner following that is to say
Item 1st In as much as I have heretofore given by deed of
gift to my son Thomas Nagland a negro girl named
Mary I consider that gift as much as he is entitled to
out of my estate he is therefore to have nothing more
out of my estate

Item 2nd I leave to my daughter Sarah Morris wife of
Benjamin Morris a negro Girl named Jane about fourteen
years old the title of which Negro I transfer to my son
Lemuel Nagland as trustee in trust for the use of the said
Sarah Morris during her natural life and after her
death my will is that the said Negro Jane and her
Increase become the property of and rest in the child
or children of the said Sarah Morris if she has any
living if not then to be divided equally amongst
my other children and their heirs

Item 3rd I also give to Lemuel Nagland the sum of
forty dollars to be by him expended for the use & benefit
of said Sarah Morris in such manner as he shall
think most to her benefit and also my riding Gig to be
held by him for the use & benefit of the said Sarah Morris
above mentioned

Item 4th I give and bequeath to my son Lemuel Nagland
a Negro man named Dick about fifty years old and
also a negro Girl by the name of Lucy about seventeen
years old and a mule commonly called Jack two cows
and calves such as he may choose out of my stock
one blue chest one walnut table one sideboard one
bed & furniture fifteen head of hogs of his own choos-
ing blacksmiths tools two Queens two pots any entire
flock of fowls one pair Andirons and one half of
such crops as may be made on the plantation
where I now live during my life

Item 5 My will is that the Remainder of my

property of all kinds not heretofore mentioned be divided
the proceeds equally divided between my children
W Nagland John A Nagland Burnell Nagland Elizabeth Cox Martha
Ann Ginn Charity Brown and Nancy Foster children to cost
the part I intended for their mother

Item 6th And lastly I hereby nominate and appoint my
Son Lemuel Nagland and Andrew M Brown my Executors
to execute this my last will and testament
