 aforesaid be sold as soon as convenient & prudently
 having regard to value & the money appropriated as my said daughters
 shall desire for their mutual benefit
- Item 5th I will that all my last debts be paid
- Item 6 - I will that my daughters select a person
 as their agent to act in selling the land in Cherokee
