of Cherokee County also a negro woman named Jane and her  
increas & such other & all the personal property in my possession

Item 3<sup>d</sup> I will that my wife Lucy shall remain with my said  
two daughters & be supported from the property herein bequeathed

Item 4 I will that my lands in Cherokee drawn in the lottery  
aforesaid be sold as soon as convenient & prudent  
having regard to value & the money appropriated as my said daughters  
shall desire for their mutual benefit

Item 5<sup>th</sup> I will that all my just debts be paid

Item 6 - I will that my daughters select a person  
as their agent to act in settling the land in Cherokee
