our heirs, Executors and Administrators, in the
whole sum jointly, and severally, and firmly by
these presents, sealed with our seals and dated
this 12th November 1827.

The condition of the
above obligation is such that if the above
bound Hugh & John, Securing for Cynthia
their administration of the goods Chattels and
Credits of Solomon Fowler late of Henry County
Georgia which have or shall come into the hands
proper or on account of the said Cynthia
Fowler or the hands, or possession of any person
or persons for her and the same so made as exhibit
unto the said Courts of ordinary when she
shall be thereunto required and such goods Chattels
and credits as well and ~~truly~~ administer according
to Law, and make a just and true account of her
doings and doings therein when she thereunto be
Required by the Court, Shall deliver and pay to such
person or persons Respectively as they may be entitled
to the same by Law, And if ~~it~~ ^{or} shall hereafter
appear, that any last will and Testament was
made by the ~~deceased~~ ^{deceased}, and the same be

proven before the Court of ordinary, And Executor
obtain a certificate of the probate thereof and
The said Cynthia Fowler in such case,
if required, render up the said Letters of
administration then this obligation to be
void else to remain in full force.
