### Solomon Strickland's Will

Georgia { In the name of God Amen I Solomon Strickland  
Henry County, of said county and State being advanced in life  
and of full health but of perfectly sound disposing mind and  
memory being desirous of disposing of my worldly goods  
do make and ordain this my last will and testament

Item first. I commit my soul to him who gave it and that  
my body be buried in a plain Christian manner.  
Item second I give unto my beloved wife the plantation whereon  
I now live together with all the household and kitchen  
furniture Stock of horses cattle hogs sheep and also a negro  
man named Tom and his wife Zephra and Susan and Mary  
two girls also Esther a negro girl and Harry a man & son to his wife

To have and to hold in her sole and entire possession during her natural life or widowhood the said property to be cultivated used and managed by my said wife subject to the superintendence of my executors for the support exclusively of my said wife and of my own children and the two orphan children of my son Bedford dead now with and it is my will that all said property remain on said plantation without removal and that the proceeds of cultivation shall be applied as aforesaid

Third I give the negro Charles to my wife to have and to hold to her and heirs forever in fee simple by subject to her own disposal  
Fourth upon the death or marriage of my wife I will to my daughter Polly Strickland the negro woman called black Mary to hold at her own

Fifth I will to my daughter Elizabeth the negro girl Esther to hold at her own  
after my wifes death or Marriage

Sixth I will that my executors hire out or sell the following negro Phil Daniel Wimsey Mary a. Nolatto and her two children and their increases for the purpose of paying off my debts especially to the children of Bedford Strickland of whom I am Guardian I leave it to be discretionary with my executors whether to sell or hire or manage them otherwise for the same purpose

seventh I give to my son Thomas J Strickland my negro Abram to hold from my death I also give to him the plantation wherein I now live to have and to hold upon the termination of my wifes estate but the use thereof for the support and maintenance of my own children and those of Bedford Stricklands orphans untill they are grown or moved away

Eighth upon the termination of my wifes estate and the the children aforesaid untill of age I give to my son Thomas J Strickland the negroes not already disposed of except my I also give to my son Thomas the use of the Island plantation separated from my home plantation so called by woolf creek untill his title to the home plantation accrues at which time I give the said Island plantation to my son Ephraim Lee and Solomon Strickland to have and to hold at their own all my other lands it is my wish that my executors sell at private or publick sale as they deem best for the purpose of paying my debts it is my will that my executors collect debts due me dad if any except remains after paying my debts that ~~that~~ except go to my two youngest children

Ninth it is my will that the crops now on my home plantation or which may be at my death go the support of my wife and the children aforesaid

as legacy & cannot emancipate my negro man  
Brister I request that Lee Strickland my son protect him  
and take care of <sup>him</sup> allowing the said Brister the entire  
fruits of his own Labour & time for the balance of his life  
Eleventh I will that my negro man Dick be allowed the  
use and fruits of his own labor and time from the expiration of  
two years after my death and place him under the care and  
protection of my son Ephriam Strickland

I gave to my Daughter Jane Shoulders the negro woman  
(excepted from Solomons gift) to have and to hold from the  
termination of the Bequest heretofore made

It is my will that my Executors allow a reasonable and  
comfortable support from the proceeds of the home plantation  
for my wife and the children to be supported but that  
they guard against waste of the property

It is my will that my sons Ephriam Lee and Solomon  
Strickland act as the executors of this will and they  
are hereby constituted Executors for that purpose

And Lastly I declare this to be my last will and testament  
hereby revoking all others in testimony whereof I have  
hereunto set my hand and Seal this the eighth day of  
August 1843
