age & knowing that I must soon depart this life & being now
of sound disposing mind and memory deem it proper to
make the following disposition of my property that I now have
or may hereafter have as follows hereby revoking & annulling
all wills heretofore made by me

— Item 1st I desire that my body be buried in a decent &
Christian like manner by the side of my deceased brother &
his grave and mine to be neatly enclosed with a rock
wall & covered with rock forming an arch the expenses
of which I desire paid out of the ready money and
notes that I may have on hand at my death

— Item 2nd After the expenses of my last illness & expenses
of burial are paid & after other debts that I may be owing
are paid I desire the half lot of Land whereon I now
live to Isaac W Grant for ever in fee simple free from
all encumbrances

— Item 3rd I devise & bequeath in addition to the
land I have above given to Isaac W Grant to take
place at my death I give all the ballance of my prop-
erty real personal & mixed of whatever nature or
description including all my house hold furniture
beds &c at my death to Sarah R A Grant infant daugh-
ter of Isaac W Grant forever in fee simple

And having placed certain little papers of doubtful
character to lot of land in the lower part of Georgia
in the hands of Peter Z Ward with verbal instruction
that if he could sell it to advantage that he
should be paid for his trouble if he succeeded
in selling I desire this arrangement fairly carried
out

Item 4th I do hereby constitute & appoint Isaac
W Grant testamentary guardian of his infant
daughter Sarah R A Grant

Lastly I constitute & appoint James E Dicken my
true & lawful Executor to carry out the provisions
of this will
