 Item 6th I Give and bequeath unto My Son Wilby J. Wefflin one lot of

 Negro Boy by the Name of Henry Peter
 Item 7th I Give and bequeath unto My Son Wyatt Wefflin one lot of
 land No seven in the Second Dist of Henry County and a Negro Boy
 named Albert and the sum of Twenty five Dollars.
 Item 8th I Give and bequeath unto My Daughter Temperance Wefflin an
 lot of land No twenty two in the Second Dist of Henry County
 Together with the Mill and Mill race on lot No 6 Sixty nine
 and an Negro Girl named Phillis

Item 9. I Give and bequeath unto My Daughter Susanah one lot of land No fifty Eight in the second Dist of Henry County and one Negro Girl named Mary and one patent Clock and Twenty five Dollars and one feather bed & bed stid furniture and cord

Item 10. I Give and bequeath unto My Daughter Sarah, Lot of land No fifty in the second Dist of Henry County and one Negro Boy by the name of Willson and Twenty five Dollars. and, feather bed furniture Bed & bed stid & Cord.

Item 11. I Give and bequeath unto My Son Wiley I Hefflin My son in trust for & for the use of My wife Hannah Hefflin and for her use and benefit during her life or widowhood a certain Negro boy by the name of Morgan and at her death or intermarriage the right of the said Negro Boy Morgan to go to and be vested in My son Wiley I Hefflin for which he the said Wiley I Hefflin is to see to the taking care of and supporting of his Mother during her life or widowhood

Item 12. I further will that a certain Negro boy by the name of Arthur with all ~~the~~ ^{the} ~~estate of~~ ^{the} perishable property be sold by My Executors and after paying all my Just debts and the necessary Expenses that may accrue in executing this will to be by My Executors equally divided among my five youngest Children

Item 13. I her by nominate and appoint Wmth Hefflin Senior and My son Wiley I Hefflin my Executors to this My last will and Testament when by Evoking all other Wills by Me made heretofore in Testamany when of I have herunto sett My hand and affixed My Seal this seventeenth day of October Eighteen hundred and Thirty Two.
