Henry County Know all persons by these presents that I Willis Moore of the county and state aforesaid being diseased in body, and not knowing the time of my departure from this world but preserving my reasoning powers with a sound disposing mind make this my last will and Testament, first I bequeath to my wife Rebecca Moore all the land whereon I now reside with my interest in the mill on said land with the exceptions herein after named (viz) the plantation to be rented for the present year with the exception of the houses, garden, orchard &c the above named land and premises to her own right and property during her widowhood or lifetime if she marries to be equally divided with herself and my children (viz) John Lewis, Mary/Sarah and Ediza with Charles Cote. I also bequeath unto Rebecca my wife an equal part with my children in all the slaves I now own (viz) Gardner Edmund Warner and Litty and her children the above named negroes to be hired out for the present year except Litty and her children, afterwards to remain on the plantation to support my wife and children and to defray the expense of my childrens schooling &c It is my wish that the stock of horses, hogs, cattle, and sheep, Cotton corn & fodder should be sold with the exceptions of a sufficiency to support to support my white family together with Litty and her children, for the present year. It is my wish that the property that I have bequeathed to my wife after her death to be equally divided amongst my children. I also wish that Lewis & Moore and Edi Conger should be my executors or legal representatives. her comfortable also my Desire is that my Daughter
Margaret McCants shall have sixty Dollars in cash and
also that my son Eli McCants have my Wagon and
Hornup and all things thereunto belonging and
further my Desire is that my Negro boy Jacob be
the property of my Wife Elizabeth and Margaret my
Daughter During their natural Life time and after
their death to become the property of my son Eli
McCants provided he should be the longest lived
and if not to his Heirs if any as to my Cherokee
Land No. 220 in the ninth Dist Morris County Georgia
and also my Lot of Forty acre Lot lying in twenty
first Dist Paulding County No. six hundred and twenty
Eight both to be sold at publick sale and
the money divided amongst all my Heirs by
equal Division and also all my Horse stock and
