and doings therein they shall be thereunto required by the
Court of ordinary for said County, and all the rest of goods chattels
and credits which shall be found remaining upon the
account of said administration, the same being first
by the Court shall deliver and pay to such person or persons
respectfully as are entitled to the same by law and if
it hereafter appear that any last will and
testament was made by the said deceased and the same
be proved before the Court & the executors obtain a
certificate of the probat thereof and said Thomas & Elizabeth
Garner in such case if required under and subject
