sum jointly, and severally and firmly by these
presents, and dated this 12th day of November 1827

The Condition of the above obligation
is Such that if the above bound Securities
for Ann Rose administratrix of the goods
chattels and credits of William Rose Late
of Henry County deceased, which have or shall
come into the hands possession or knowledge of
the said Ann Rose Administratrix or
or the hands or possession of any person or
persons for her and the same to make do
Exhibit unto the said Court of Ordinary when
she shall be thereunto required, and such goods
chattels and credits do well and truly administer
according to Law and do make a Just and true
account of her actings and doings therein
when she shall thereunto be required by the Court
shall deliver and pay to such person or persons
respectively as they may be entitled to the
same by Law, And if it shall hereafter
appear that any Last Will and Testament

was made by the Deceased, and the same be proven before the Court of Ordinary and Executor obtain a Certificate of the probate thereof and the said Ann Rose in such case if ~~Required~~ render up the said Letters of Administration then their obligation to be void else to remain in full force.
