publish this as my last will and testament

1st I resign my body to its mother earth and my soul
to God who gave it

2 I desire that my debts be paid the first thing out
of my property

3rd I will and desire that my property all remain to
my wife as in my lifetime with my wife and
children to carry out their common calling as
heretofore and as the children shall marry or
be come of age to draw out of the common
stocks their share. I wish my wife to be placed
on the same footing as the children to have a
child's part - part of the property and in case
she should marry at any time during the
minority of any of my children - in that

court a general division to take place between him
and the children so that each may have his pro-
portionate share

4th If any of the negroes should become ungovern-
able by the family I wish them sold off as soon
as convenient otherwise to remain together

5th I appoint Henry C. Merritt as executor to execute
this testament according to its tenor effect
