in the whole & for the whole sum jointly, &
severally & firmly by these presents, sealed with
ourselves, & dated this seventh day of May
1827. The condition of the above obli-
gation is such that if the above bound Lewis
Ferguson & William H. Wyatte do Administer all
the goods Chatter & Credits of the said William Wy-
atte deceased late of said Henry County deceased
which have or shall come into the hands possession
or knowledge of the said Lewis Ferguson & William
Wyatte Adms. or the ^{hand} of any person or persons for
for them and the same, & the same so made
as Exhibit unto the said Court of ordinary, when
they shall be thereunto required, & such goods, Chat-
tels & Credits as well & truly Administer Accord-
ing to Law, & do make a just and true account
of their actings & doings therein when they shall
there unto be required by the Court: Shall deliver
to such person or persons respectively, as they
may be entitled by law, & if it shall hereafter
appear, that any last Will & Testament was
made by the deceased and the same

known before the Court of ordinary,
and Executor obtain a certificate of the probat thereof
and in such cases if required, under and deliver up to
said Letter of Administration then this obligation
to be void else to remain in full force.
