Court of Ordinary for said County. &
their successors in office in the full
and full sum of twenty five hundred dollars
for the payment of which sum, to the said
Judges and their successors in office we
bind ourselves our heirs Executors and
Administrators, jointly & severally, firmly
by these presents. Sealed with our seals
and dated this 6th day of May 1828

The condition of the above obligation
is such, That whereas the said John
P. Wyatt is this day appointed Guardian
to John P. Wyatt deaf and dumb son of
William Wyatt deceased now if the said
John P. Wyatt do well & truly demean himself
as Guardian aforesaid agreeably to Letters
of Guardianship bearing even date here
with, and agreeably to Law in such case
made and provided the above obligation
to be void, otherwise to remain in full
force & virtue — Signed sealed
and acknowledged in open court
