me I therefore make this my last will and Testament
freely revoking and annulling all others heretofore
made by me

Item 1st I desire and direct that my body Buried
in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to
My circumstances and condition my soul I Trust shall
return to rest with God who gave it as I hope for
Eternal Salvation through the Blessed Saviour and
Saviour Jesus Christ whose religion I have professed
And as I humbly trust enjoy

Item 2^d I desire and direct that all my just debts
be paid with out delay by Executors herein after named
As I am unwilling my creditors should be delayed
of their rights

Item 3^d I give and devise to my beloved Wife Dorothy
with whom I have lived in the strictest quietude all
of my Personal Property during her natural life

Item 4th I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife
for and during her natural life my Negro Boy
Jeff and my Negro Girl Harriet junior that is black
Harriet

Item 5th I devise to my son Gabuea M. Little my
Negro Dick to be given to him when he becomes twenty
one years of age or when he gets married

Item 6th I devise to my daughter Mary Jane my
Negro girl yellow Harriet to be given her when she becomes
twenty one years of age or when she gets Married

Item 7th I devise and give to my daughter Catharine
my Negro girl Caroline to be hers at the age of twenty one
or when she gets Married

Item 8th I devise to my son Adam my Negro boy Green
to be given to him at the age of twenty one years or when
ever he gets Married

Item 9th I devise and give to my son Demasthones my
Negro boy Elijah to be given to him when he becomes twenty
one years of age or when he gets Married

Item 10th I devise and give to my son Bay Kendrick
My negro Boy Robin to be given to him at the age of
Twenty one years of age or when he gets Married

Item 11th I devise and give to my wife my negro Boy
Jim and my negro Boy Asely and my negro Woman
Hanny also my negro woman Martha for and during the
natural life of wife

Also all of the real estate to gether with all my stock
And farming utensils are to be my wife's until her
death then it is to be sold and equally divided among
My children

Item 12th I want my negro man Sam and a
negro girl named Jane and a girl by the name of Seally
all to be sold on the first Tuesday in December next
in the town of McDonough to the highest bidder for
Cash

Item 13th I desire that what money those three negroes
Bring be appropriated to the payment of my debts and
If there be any more left after paying all of my
just debts it shall be equally divided among my
children

Item 14th I give to my daughter Amanda E
Ponder Five Dollars

Item 15th I give to my daughter Margaret Ann
Kising Five Dollars

Item 16th I constitute and appoint John H. Starr of
the afore said State and County and Leroy M. Cobb
of the afore said State and County my Executors to
this my last will and Testament
