this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking and annulling
all others heretofore made by me —
Item first I desire & direct that my body be buried
in a decent & a Christian like manner suitable to my
circumstances & condition my soul I trust shall
return to rest with God who gave it — as I hope for
Eternal Salvation through the blessed Lord & Saviour
Jesus Christ whose religion I have professed & as a
reasonable trust enjoyed for twenty years =

Item Second I desire & direct that all my just debts be
paid without delay by my Executor herein after mentioned
as I am committing that my Creditors should be delayed
there rights & specially as there is no need civilly for
any of them Third = I give & devise to my beloved
and genuine wife with whom I have lived in the
latest part & save for fifteen years a certain
lot or and it being a part of a lot numbered one hundred
& twenty six in the first district of Irwin County
containing two hundred & ninety acres about forty acres
of which are cleared & in Cultivation with all the
rights & appurtenances to said parcel of
land in any ways appertaining or belonging to or
and charge or limitation whatever to be now
upon the same & to have & to hold during her natural life
and the same I give —
Item fourth I place & give & bequeath to my wife
the sum of \$1000 — to be paid by my Executor
within six months after my death

and large chest & spinning wheel & Loom
and some head of stock & cattle the balance
of my property to be sold & Equally divided
among my dear wife & heirs -
I therefore I constitute and appoint my son
Samuel Brown and Smith Lerner Executors
to this my Last Will & Testament this
month day of October 1847-
