but I shall at the day of Resurrection receive
the same again by the mighty power of god
and as to the worldly estate which it
hath pleased Almighty god to bestow on
me I give unto my beloved wife Barbara
James appointing her my legal and sole
Executrix of this my Last Will and
Testament to dispose of at her discretion
this 5 day of November 1810

appointed guardian to John Adams orphan of
Wiles Adams now if the said Smith Turner
do well and truly demean himself as guardian
as aforesaid agreeably to letters of Guardianship
bearing even date herewith and agreeable to law
in such case made and provided the above obligation
to be paid otherwise to remain in full force and
virtue Signed Sealed
