Item 2nd I give & bequeath to my wife Mary Ann & my three
Sons Viz Alexander N. Horatio M. & Cicero 1 Bed and
furniture to each of them to be Valued at forty Dollars
and it is further my Will that my stock of horses
hays & Cattle be equally Divided between my wife
Mary Ann & my three sons Alexander N. Horatio M. and
Cicero to put them upon a footing with my other
Children who have heretofore Received an Equivalent
& I further give to my son Cicero one Hundred and
Twenty five Dollars for his Board & Schooling for one year

Item 3rd It is my Will & Desire that all the Balance
My Estate both Real & Personal be sold at public
Sale to the best advantage & the Proceeds thereof
to be equally Divided between my wife & my Children
herein after named (Viz) Thomas J. Edwin P. Edgar
Alfred H. Alexander N. Horatio M. & Cicero
Daughters of the said W. Morrison Trust for my Daughter
Harriet C. Hood & to Thomas J. Morrison Trust for my
Daughter Elizabeth B. Bacon the two last legacies
Subject to the following Direction the Portion I
hereby Desire for my Daughter Harriet C. Hood
to be left in the hands of my son Alfred W. In Trust
for my said Daughter Harriet C. Hood to be paid
to her as he may think of Most Interest to my said
Daughter & her Children & after her Death to be
Equally Divided between her Children the Portion I
Desire for my said Daughter Elizabeth B. Bacon
to be left in the hands of my son Thomas J.

Went for my said Daughter Elizabeth H. B. Bacon
 to be bound to her as he may think of most
 Interest to my said Daughter & her Children & after
 Death to be Equally Divided between husband &
 Son & I hereby nominate constitute & appoint my sons
 Thomas W. & I Married W. Morrison & my son in law
 Charles Daugherty to be my Executors to carry into
 Effect this my Last Will & Testament
