of sound mind. do appoint my son Uriah Dameron my executor &
my last will & testament

1st I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Polly Dameron all my personal
estate, property, present & one and half hereafter to be disposed of & managed
natural life & after her decease to be equally divided between
my son Uriah Dameron & my daughter Peggy & Nancy and
the children of my daughter Polly Anglin & also my plantation
whom I now live during her life together with its appurtenances
I give & bequeath to my wife Polly a note which I hold
on Asa Varnum

2nd I give & bequeath to my son Uriah the plantation that
I have whereon I now live after the decease of his mother

3rd I give & bequeath to my daughter Nancy Dameron the tract
of land known as the Edwards tract

4th I give & bequeath to my daughter Peggy Dameron one half of the
tract of land whereon Peter Anglin now lives

5th I give & bequeath ^{my son Uriah Dameron} the other half of my tract whereon Peter Anglin
now lives in trust for the sole use & benefit of my daughter
Polly Anglin & after her death to her children

6th I give & bequeath unto my son in law Peter Anglin one and half
now in his possession

7th And it is my desire that my executor shall sell all the lands
which I have drawn up the late land letter of George
whom it can be done to the best advantage for the
purpose of paying my debts & the support of my family
