this my last will & Testament hereby Revoking others heretofore made by me
I Do give & Devise that my body be buried in a decent & Christian like
Manner suitable to my circumstances & Condition in Decease my Soul I
must shall Return to that better life to which I as I hope for Eternal
Salvation through the merits & attonement of the blessed Lord & Jesus
Christ whose Religion I have professed & as I humbly Trust Enjoy
for many years

I Do give & Devise that all my just Debts be paid without Delay by my
Executor hereafter appointed as I am unwilling my Creditors should
be Delayed in their Rights Especially as there is no necessity for Delay

I Do give & Devise that my beloved wife Frances Harrison to have the
plantation I now live on with one negro girl by the name of Letitia
& her youngest child & her servants & after my wife Frances Death
Cynthia & her child & there is any Servants of said negro to be sold
by my Executors & be Divided Equally amongst all my legal heirs

I Do give & bequeath that Boy (Rash) to go to my Son Joseph Harrison
being like as Dead that said Boy be Equally Divided between all of
my Son Joseph's heirs as they think proper

I Do give & bequeath that my negro Boy by Name of Joe go to my
Son Jason C. Harrison by him paying two hundred Dollars to a note
that Jason C. Harrison hold against Thaddeus S. Harrison and I as
Security to the said note

I Do give that Abram & Mary his wife to be sold & my Son in Laws
Hillard J. Randolph & Family H. Randolph to have out of the profits
of Abram & his wife Mary Hillard J. Randolph to have three hundred
Dollars & Family H. Randolph four hundred Dollars to be paid by the
Executors of my will

I Do give that my Son Thaddeus S. Harrison to have my negro Boy
George for full Sample

I Do give that my Daughter Melissa Ann to have a negro girl by Name
of Peloria in Trust of my Son Thaddeus S. Harrison for Melissa Ann
her heirs not be subject to be present husband or any future

Husband's Debt that she may have Debt only for her & body being I mean
Melissa Ann

I Do give that all the Debt of my said Husband
George & Carriage that I owe to my beloved wife Frances the balance of
my place known as the Right place to be sold my Executors hereafter
named & after paying all my just Debts the Remainder to be Equally Divided
Equally between my three heirs Thaddeus S. Harrison & make an
Hillside & Sarah D. Brown for them & their body heirs

I Do give that my Son Dr. John C. Harrison to have a negro boy by
the name of Daniel in full Sample
then the hereby constitute & appoint my Son in Law Thomas S. Brown
Jason C. Harrison & Thaddeus S. Harrison Executors of this my last will &
Testament the first February 1857

presence of said Testator at his aforesaid Testament & August 4 of each other this
1st February 1857
