my last will & Testament hereby set of hand and  
Sealing my mind & memory do make Publish & Declare this  
to be my last will & Testament revoking hereby all other  
Wills & Testaments by me hitherto made I will that my  
beloved Mother have my Negro girl Phyllis & her Increase  
During her natural life also the residue of my Estate During  
her life time for her Support & Maintenance at the Death  
of my Mother I will bequeath & desire that my Negro  
girl Phyllis & her Increase & all of my Estate left to my  
Mother her life time & the whole of Estate claim I hereby  
which I hold, Owner of Land wherein my Mother now  
lives &c to my beloved Sister Eliza Willingham to her &  
the Heir of her body in full power now I hold over  
beloved Sister Eliza Willingham die without having a Husband  
or Children then & in that case I will that the whole of my  
Estate above named be equally divided among my surviving  
brother or their children should they leave any  
I nominate Constitute & appoint my beloved Sister Eliza Willing-  
ham Executrix of this my last will & Testament for  
Execution wherefore I have written it in my hand & seal this

Tollerton Chancery before me

Woolsey County & Chandler & Samuel Swan who being  
Sworn doth swear they saw Harriet  
Wellington sign the written will & that they believe her  
to be at the time of signing & disposing of property  
and that they still have Mr. Chandler subscribed  
the same as witnesses.
