 Equally Divided between My four Daughters (My) Susanah Bradley

 Thirdly I Give & bequeath to my Son Joshua H. Randolph as agent and trust
 for My Grand Daughter Mary Ann Caroline Horton five Hundred
 Dollars of My Estate to be held by him for the use of My said Grand
 Daughter Mary Ann Caroline Horton (now Wood) to be appropriated
 fifty Dollars annually for ten years for the benefit of her & her
 heirs & at the Death of her the said Mary Ann Caroline Wood
 the Sum shall be Equally Divided among her sons or children
 if she should die before the next payment when they become
 of age be Equally Divided among them & I desire it Exemption
 with the Interest whether he pays any Interest or not
