- 1st It is my will that all my debts be punctually paid out of my estate together with my funeral expenses by my executor herein after named.
- 2nd I will & bequeath unto Charles Daugherty Senior of the county aforesaid one lot of land shown in my return known as the last land lottery by lot N^o 180 in the third District of Lee County to him & his heirs forever, the said Charles Daugherty to pay for the grant of said lot of land
- 3rd I do hereby appoint the said Charles Daugherty Senior my executor to this my last will & testament. In witness whereof I have unto set my hand & seal the 16th day of June 1830
