bequeathed in the first Item

Item 3rd In the Event that I should Die before the close of the year
I give my Myself to Remain on the Plantation until the
Crop is gathered

Item 4th It is my Will that my Friend Caroline Story have my
Wearing apparel

Item 5th I hereby appoint Giles Mitchell Executor of this my
Last Will & Testament hereby Revoking all former Wills
In Writing Wharof I have hereto And my hand & Seal this
5th Day of March 1850
